PROVEN SUCCESS:

- Generally, two-thirds of the LTC students scored one level higher on the OPI test taken at the end of the course compared to the beginning of the course.



CONCORDIA LANGUAGE TRAINING CENTER

Concordia College is one of eight Language Training Centers (LTC) in the United States, funded by the Defense Language and National Security Education Office (DLNSEO), and administered by the Institute of International Education (IIE).

The Concordia LTC was established in 2016 in collaboration with the 300th MI Brigade of the Utah National Guard. For the 2019-20 academic year, the Concordia LTC will provide residential iso-immersion programs in partnership with the 300th MI BDE of the Utah National Guard and the Twenty-Fifth Air Force (25 AF) of San Antonio, TX. The languages offered during the 2019/20 academic year: Arabic (MSA and Levantine), Mandarin Chinese, French, Hebrew, Korean, Persian Farsi, Russian, and Spanish.

At Concordia Language Villages, our approach to language teaching puts learners into a grand simulation which includes the need to apply the target language via context-based situated learning and being surrounded by meaningful elements of a culturally authentic setting.

SITUATED LEARNING

Through the iso-immersion experience of this residential training program, participants focus on learning an average of ten hours per day, including an intentional mix of formal and informal immersion program elements, away from distractions of daily life, guided by a blend of native speakers and highly proficient US-based instructors. The instructor to learner ratio is 1:2, with no more than three students per academic class, providing for extensive opportunities to engage and find support in the learning process. This full immersion, "living the language" environment creates an environment for accelerated learning and advancing linguistic as well as cultural competencies. Courses target students aiming to achieve 2 or 2+ and higher on the next DLPT.

The Concordia Language Villages iso-immersion model builds competence and confidence, enabling learners to readily transfer their expanded skills to real-life situations in their daily work. Instruction consists of a blend of integrated cultural immersion elements including:

- Hands-on activities
- Role-playing of tailored scenarios (operational, cultural, risk assessment)
- Authentic meals (food and customs)
- Sports and cultural activities

This rich environment provides opportunities for deep learning in formal and authentic settings.
